Dabei wird der Zeitraum seit Beginn der Koalition von Conservative Party und Liberal Democrats im Mai 2010 bis zur Ankündigung Camerons, ein Referendum abhalten zu wollen, im Januar 2013, betrachtet. Analysiert wird Camerons Entscheidung mithilfe der Referendumstheorie, die sich damit beschäftigt, warum Regierungen freiwillig Referenden initiieren, obwohl sie dazu nicht verpflichtet sind. Für die Analyse wird dabei die Referendumstheorie verwendet. Mithilfe dieser Theorie soll nachvollzogen werden, welche Faktoren dazu beigetragen haben, dass Cameron eine Entscheidung für ein Referendum über die EU-Mitgliedschaft Großbritanniens getroffen hat. In dieser Arbeit wird deshalb zunächst die Referendumstheorie erläutert. Am Ende des Kapitels werden dann die Hypothesen aufgestellt, die im Laufe der Arbeit überprüft werden sollen. Anschließend wird in der Operationalisierung darauf eingegangen, wie die Theorie im vorliegenden Fall angewendet werden kann, bevor dann die Analyse durchgeführt wird und die Ergebnisse präsentiert werden. Abschließend wird ein Fazit gezogen.

Die kommunikative Leadership von David Cameron im Vorfeld des Brexit-Referendums Lucas Schramm, 2017-07-10 Masterarbeit aus dem Jahr 2017 im Fachbereich Politik - Internationale Politik - Thema: Europäische Union, Note: 1,3, Universität Trier (Fachbereich III - Politikwissenschaft), Sprache: Deutsch, Abstract: Am 23. Juni 2016 stimmten die Bewohner des Vereinigten Königreichs in einem Referendum mit einer Mehrheit von 51,9 zu 48,1% dafür, dass ihr Land aus der EU austreten soll. Trotz des jahrzehntelangen, in weiten Teilen der britischen Gesellschaft verankerten Euroskeptizismus' und der Umfragen in den Tagen vor der Abstimmung, die einen EU-Austritt als realistische Option zeigten, schienen bei Cameron und seinen Anhängern die Zuversicht (und Hoffnung) zu dominieren, dass sich letztlich doch eine Mehrheit der Briten für einen Verbleib in der EU entscheiden würde. Nach einer Reihe von Siegen in nationalen Wahlen und Referenden war das britische EU-Referendum die schwierigste aller politischen Kampagnen für Cameron, da er sich erstmals einer gespaltenen Partei und einer Medienlandschaft gegenüber sah, die sich überwiegend gegen sein politisches Vorhaben

positioniert hatte. Wichtiger aber noch war der Umstand, dass Cameron als gemäßigter EU-Skeptiker nun in vergleichsweise kurzer Zeit gegenüber der eigenen Bevölkerung um die Vorzüge der britischen EU-Mitgliedschaft werben musste. Wie konnte und sollte ihm dieser Spagat gelingen? Welche Rolle spielte Cameron in der Remain-Kampagne? Mit welchen Argumentations- und Deutungsmustern versuchte er zu überzeugen? Und inwiefern trägt er Verantwortung für das aus seiner Sicht negative Votum? Die politikwissenschaftliche Aufarbeitung des Brexit, seiner Gründe und Folgen steht erst am Anfang. Conversely, he has been criticised by figures on both the left and right, and has been accused of political opportunism and elitism. Cameron appeared on the Forbes List of The World's Most Powerful People from 2010.
