I patti collettivi verranno fatte con noi o senza di noi e con noi o senza di noi saranno fattori decisivi della politica internazionale dell'Europa e del mondo.“ Mit diesen Worten wird Italiens Ministerpräsident Alcide de Gasperi im Jahre 1949 zitiert, Zeilen, welche nicht nur für die junge italienische Republik, sondern auch für deren Außenpolitik für die kommenden Jahrzehnte von großer Bedeutung sein werden. Nach dem Ende des zweiten Weltkriegs und der Konstituierung der Repubblica Italiana sollte der alles überschattende Ost-West Konflikt multilaterale Pakte und Entscheidungen im Rahmen der Außenpolitik überwiegend beeinflussen. „I patti collettivi“ wie de Gasperi sagt, waren in dieser Zeit bereits am entstehen und Italien hatte in der Tat nur die Wahl auf einen der beiden Züge aufzuspringen, denn auch ohne das Land wären die wichtigsten Weichenstellungen in den internationalen Beziehungen unternommen worden. In den folgenden Jahren sollten „la scelta per l'occidente ed il principio di non-esclusione“ die italienische Strategie in der Außenpolitik bestimmen und zu einer bemerkenswerten Stringenz führen. Während das Nichtausgeschlossenensein eine Art bandwagoning Effekt der Bipolarität gewesen ist, subsumierte sich die Wahl des Westblocks aus eindeutigen ökonomischen und (geo)politischen Vorteilen, was noch zu erläutern sein wird. Die Gradlinigkeit dieser beiden außenpolitischen Hauptprinzipien ist besonders im Vergleich zur innenpolitischen Instabilität der italienischen ersten Republik bis 1992/3 und der darauf folgenden Parteienkrise hin zur so genannten 2. Republik, bemerkenswert. International natürlich durch den engen Handlungsrahmen des Ost-West Konfliktes geprägt, erwies sich diese außenpolitische Stringenz für die schwankende innenpolitische Lage des Landes des Öfteren als politischer „Katalysator“. Veränderungen des Spieles auf internationaler Ebene wirkten sich dann positiv auf das innenpolitische Spiel aus, die stets von systemimmanenten Schwächen und gesellschaftlicher Polarisierung geprägte innenpolitische Ebene aus. Überraschenderweise ebte dieser zwei Ebenen Effekt auch nach der Wende 1989 respektive nach der Transformation der italienischen Republik 1992/3 nicht ab, was ebenfalls im Folgenden noch zu analysieren sein wird.

Governing Fear Gianfranco Baldini,Anna Cento Bull,2009 In 2008, Silvio Berlusconi returned to power — thanks to a decisive electoral victory — to head a slimmer coalition whose cabinet consisted of members very close to him. The year began with the garbage crisis in Naples and ended in a climate dominated by economic uncertainty. In between some unexpected events happened: during the administrative elections, held with the general elections in April, the right in Rome claimed many victories; for the first time ever, a woman, Emma Marcegaglia, was elected President of Confindustria; and the Alitalia airline had to be rescued from the brink of economic collapse. For consecutive months, opinion polls gave Berlusconi an unprecedented level of popular support; those polled attributed their approval to either his 'decisionism' or to what they

viewed as a successful strategy of continual announcements. Others pointed to the executive's success in 'governing the fears' of Italians, which was helped by a change of register in the way the media dealt with issues of security. This volume shows that the politics of vetoes, which characterised the previous center-left government, could not conceal the structural, economic and social problems that still need to be resolved, a situation not helped by the fact that the opposition parties were still unable to develop an effective political strategy by yearend. With the contribution of Italian and international experts, the volume also addresses the issues of the difficult integration of immigrants, the mismanagement of public health and the reform of the education.

I primi provvedimenti dei commissari riguardano la cancellazione del welfare, la vendita del patrimonio immobiliare, il licenziamento di personale. Con i tagli alla sanità sono stati soppressi numerosi presidi, le scuole chiudono, i servizi sociali non esistono più. Lo Stato chiude i battenti. Dal 1994, in cambio della cancellazione di ogni regola urbanistica, la cultura liberista aveva promesso un nuovo «rinascimento urbano». Sono state invece create immense periferie senza servizi e senza anima. La sovrapproduzione edilizia ha provocato il crollo dei valori immobiliari, cosicché le famiglie italiane, già colpite dalla crisi economica e dalla disoccupazione, vedono scomparire i servizi sociali e il valore della propria abitazione. Povertà e insicurezza per tutti. Il fallimento delle politiche neoliberaliste è evidente, eppure i responsabili del disastro economico e sociale continuano ad approvare leggi di liquidazione delle proprietà pubbliche e di ulteriore cancellazione del welfare. Con il decreto Sblocca Italia si mette il patrimonio immobiliare pubblico nelle mani della finanza, e mentre il paese affonda nel fango per il dissesto

idrogeologico, si continua con la politica delle grandi opere inutili, nonostante gli scandali e le ruberie che ne caratterizzano l'esecuzione. Le città falliscono perché non riescono a garantire i servizi all'enorme periferia costruita negli ultimi anni: è dunque ora di fermare ogni espansione urbana. E invece di essere svendute alla speculazione finanziaria globale, come in Grecia o in Portogallo, le proprietà pubbliche devono diventare il volano per creare lavoro per i giovani. Il liberismo ha imposto la cancellazione delle pubbliche amministrazioni e ha fallito. Per uscire dalla crisi occorre mutare paradigma: ricostruire le città pubbliche e il welfare urbano.
