Vom PCI zum PDS - Die Sozialdemokratisierung der italienischen kommunistischen Partei Petra Buß, 2007 Studienarbeit aus dem Jahr 1999 im Fachbereich Politik - Internationale Politik - Region: Westeuropa, Note: 1,0, Westfälische Wilhelms-Universität Münster (Institut für Politikwissenschaft), Veranstaltung: Hauptseminar: Sozialdemokratische Parteien im internationalen Vergleich, Sprache: Deutsch, Abstract: Der Partito Comunista Italiano (PCI) war seit Ende des Zweiten Weltkrieges, nach kurzer anfänglicher Regierungsbeziehung, stärkste Oppositionspartei in Italien. Er wurde aufgrund des sich zuspitzenden Kalten Krieges vehement von der Regierung ausgeschlossen, gewann aber dennoch bis in die siebziger Jahre hinein kontinuierlich an Wählerstimmen. Grund für den Vormarsch der Kommunisten war das große Ansehen, das sie als führende Kraft im Widerstand gegen den Faschismus besaßen. Sie hatten ziemlich schnell und konsequent eine schlagkräftige Organisation aufgebaut, eroberten in den ersten Nachkriegsjahren die wichtigste Schlüsselposition in den Gewerkschaften und stellten die eigentliche Opposition gegen die Regierung in der Polarisierung des Kalten Krieges dar. Trotz einer kurzen Phase in den siebziger Jahren, in der sie die Mehrheit unterstützten, mußte die Partei bis 1996, fünf Jahre nach der Namensänderung in den Partito Democratico della Sinistra (PDS), warten, um zum ersten Mal als stärkste Partei die Verantwortung für das Land übernehmen zu können. Die vorliegende Arbeit beschäftigt sich mit dem Sozialdemokratisierungsprozeß der italienischen Kommunisten, der sich über mehr als 70 Jahre erstreckte. Dabei sollen die einzelnen Phasen genau betrachtet und analysiert werden. Ziel ist es zu klären, warum sich der PCI diesen Veränderungen unterzog, wie er in den einzelnen Phasen versucht hat, sich von Moskau zu lösen und ob es ihm jeweils gelungen ist. In diesem Zusammenhang können sowohl internationale als auch nationale Ereignisse von Bedeutung sein, sofern sie direkten Einfluß auf die Entwicklung der Partei hatten.

Das italienische Parteiensystem Beate Sewald, 2002-03-22 Studienarbeit aus dem Jahr 2001 im Fachbereich Politik - Region: Westeuropa, Note: 1,3, Universität Augsburg (Institut für Politikwissenschaften), Veranstaltung: Systemvergleich: Italien-Spanien-Griechenland, Sprache: Deutsch, Abstract: Einführung Im Rahmen des Proseminars: „Systemvergleich: Griechenland – Italien – Spanien“ habe ich mich in Form eines Referates und dieser Hausarbeit näher mit dem Parteiensystem Italiens beschäftigt. Das Besondere am italienischen Parteiensystem ist sowohl die 40jährige Alleinherrschaft der Democrazia Cristiana, als auch die Zäsur am Anfang der 90er Jahre. Nach dem jahrzehntelangen Machterhalt der Christdemokraten, gewannen seit 1990 immer mehr neue Parteien an Bedeutung, während die einstige Volkspartei zerfiel. Trotz dieses Wechsels blieben jedoch viele der alten Strukturen bestehen. Schon immer kennzeichnete Italiens Parteienlandschaft eine starke Fragmentierung und Polarisierung, sowie überdurchschnittlich häufige Regierungswechsel. Gründe hierfür lassen sich weit zurückführen, deshalb behandelt der erste Teil der Arbeit die Geschichte Italiens, besonders das „risorgimento“ und die Entwicklung des Faschismus in der ersten Hälfte des 20. Jahrhunderts. Des weiteren werden die allgemeinen Grundzüge und die Entwicklung der italienischen Parteien dargestellt, sowie deren Status in der Verfassung. Teil zwei geht auf bekannte Phänomene der politischen Kultur in Italien ein, wie den Klientelismus oder den Transformismus, außerdem werden die relevanten Parteien der „ersten Republik“ vorgestellt, die Ergebnisse in Teil drei zusammengefasst und im Zusammenhang betrachtet. Von diesen Parteien ist heute keine mehr existent und so werden im vierten Teil die Parteien der „zweiten Republik“ besprochen. Dabei wird, wegen ihrer Bedeutung für das heutige Parteiensystem, ein besonderes Augenmerk auf die Lega Nord gelegt. Im Anschluss beschäftigt sich die Arbeit mit den Gründen für die häufigen Regierungswechsel, sowie mit bestehenden und gewandelten cleavages. Abschließend fasst Teil sechs die Ergebnisse nochmals kurz zusammen und beleuchtet was sich nun wirklich in der sogenannten „zweiten Republik“ geändert hat. Ferner

Marcus Grän, 2008-10-13 Studienarbeit aus dem Jahr 2008 im Fachbereich Politik - Region: Westeuropa, Note: 1,3, Universität Hamburg (Institut für Politische Wissenschaft), Veranstaltung: Reformen und institutioneller Wandel im politischen System Italiens, Sprache: Deutsch, Abstract: In Zusammenhang mit dem politischen System Italiens, wird man im Regelfall zuerst an die hohe Anzahl an Regierungskrisen und wechselnden Ministerpräsidenten denken, die das Land seit dem Zweiten Weltkrieg regiert haben. Das verwundert den Betrachter umso mehr, als dass eine Partei, die Democrazia Cristiana (DC), an allen Regierungen zwischen 1946 und 1994 beteiligt gewesen ist und bis auf wenige Ausnahmen den Regierungschef gestellt hat. Diese Serie ging jedoch zu Beginn der 90er Jahre zu Ende. Zu diesem Zeitpunkt deckten Richter in Mailand in großem Umfang illegale Parteienfinanzierungen auf und fanden heraus, dass sich dabei Politiker fast aller Parteien persönlich bereichert hatten (Trautmann, 1999:534f). Über Jahrzehnte hatte sich in Italien eine Parteienfinanzierung etabliert, die in Europa einzigartig war. Meist zahlten Unternehmen hohe Beträge, so genannte "Abgaben" (tangenti), unter anderem an Beamte, Parlamentarier, Minister und Parteipolitiker, um so die Erteilung öffentlicher Aufträge durch Gemeinden, Regionen und den Staat sicher zu stellen. (ebd.) In der Folge führte dies zu einem Zusammenbruch des etablierten Parteiensystems. Viele Parteien kamen ihrem Verbot zuvor und lösten sich auf oder gingen in anderen Parteien auf. So auch die Democrazia Cristiana. Es entstanden neue Parteien und Gruppierungen und viele Stimmen in der politischen Wissenschaft sprechen seitdem von der Existenz der zweiten italienischen Republik. Diese Hausarbeit versucht anhand des Umbruchs im italienischen Parteiensystems zu ermitteln, ob in diesem Zusammenhang tatsächlich von einer zweiten Republik, als Abgrenzung zur ersten Republik, gesprochen werden kann oder ob möglicherweise Zweifel angebracht sind, weil bestimmte Bedingungen nicht erfüllt sind. Beppe Grillo's Five Star Movement Filippo Tronconi, 2016-03-09 In 2009 Beppe Grillo, a well-known Italian comedian, established the Five Star Movement with the aim of sending a handful of citizens to municipal councils to act as the watchdog of a professional political class often perceived as corrupt and self-interested. However, in the Italian general elections of February 2013, despite still largely being considered a small protest movement, the party gained the undisputed role of leading political actor gaining just under 9 million votes and sending 163 Deputies and Senators to the Italian parliament. The birth and rapid rise of the Five Star Movement represents an electoral earthquake with no parallels in Italy and the whole of post-1945 Western Europe and a phenomenon likely to shape the Italian political scene for many years to come. Drawing on an extensive array of data and face-to-face interviews, this volume offers an empirically grounded explanation of the surprising electoral success of the Five Star Movement and presents a realistic picture of this party in its manifold aspects: organisational structure, communication style, linkages with civil society, ideological nature and positioning in the Italian political system.

Doch anders als eine deutsche Stadt steht die Region in den Alpen seit jeher im Zentrum interstaatlicher Konflikte und spätestens seit Mitte des 20. Jahrhunderts einer ausgeprägten gesellschaftlichen

Fragmentierung gegenüber. Über 65% der Bevölkerung sind Deutsche Muttersprachler, etwa 25% Italienische Muttersprachler und circa 4% gehören der Ladinischen Gruppierung von Muttersprachlern an. Gerade diese gesellschaftliche Fragmentierung führt, so argumentiert beispielsweise der österreichische Politikwissenschaftler Günther Pallaver Ende des 20. Jahrhunderts, zu einer politischen Kultur, die durch Konsens gekennzeichnet ist. Doch seit Ende des 20. Jahrhunderts hat sich das Parteinspektrum in Südtirol drastisch verändert: Während beispielsweise die rechtsextreme Partei die Freiheitlichen 2003 nur zwei Mandate erreichte, ist sie seit der Landtagswahl 2013 mit sechs Mandatsträgern zweitstärkste Partei. Die eher moderate Südtiroler Volkspartei (SVP), die von 1948 bis 2003 bei allen Landtagswahlen eine absolute Mehrheit bei Stimmen und Mandaten verzeichnete, verlor zunächst 2008 die absolute Mehrheit der Stimmen und 2013 die absolute Mehrheit der Mandate. Trotz dieser einschneidenden Ereignisse bilden jedoch mit der christdemokratischen deutsch-ladinischen SVP und der linksorientierten italienischen Partito Democratico (PD) zwei eher divergierende Parteien seit 2003 fortan die Landesregierung.

Valori e principi i cui riferimenti sono da sempre collocati nell'area di sinistra, un area vasta che però comprende, per gli stessi valori e principi, istanze che vanno dalle posizioni più radicali e ortodosse a quelle più moderate e moderne, oggi genericamente definite riformiste. Dico subito che non sono mai stato attratto dalle posizioni radicali e ortodosse, anche perché ispirate a modelli che hanno determinato il fallimento delle società che l'hanno perseguitate, benché in alcune occasioni, in Italia sono state preferibili a chi usava gli stessi principi e gli stessi valori per opportunismi personali e di parte politica finalizzata al puro esercizio del potere. Quando nel 1995, nacque l'idea di far nascere un movimento che voleva riunire sotto un unico cartello politico le aspirazioni ideali dell'intera area della sinistra, convertendole e sintetizzandole in un pacchetto di interventi e riforme che puntavano a modernizzare il Paese coniugando i valori e i

E' vero le complessità in gioco sono enormi, il nostro Paese è ormai al collasso economico e sociale, gli interventi richiesti sono drastici e presuppongono interventi pesanti a carico dei cittadini, ma non c'è scampo un partito come il nostro deve assumersi le responsabilità di dire e fare quello che serve, facendo però capire ai cittadini che noi abbiamo una visione di prospettiva che porterà a normalizzare e far crescere il nostro Paese sul piano del benessere economico sociale e civile in modo equo e solidale. Ecco perché mi aspetto che finalmente il mio partito parli chiaramente ai cittadini rivolgendosi a loro in modo strutturato e concreto, non per spot e con proposte di riforme disarticolate e confuse come ha fatto fino ad oggi ma con un progetto rappresentato in un vero e proprio Manifesto Politico dove si affrontano gli argomenti che prioritariamente toccano l'esistenza dei cittadini e con le ricette che noi proponiamo per la loro soluzione, soluzioni che devono rispondere ai principi e ai valori di riferimento della sinistra.
