Dieser Spruch, so Paul Steinhardt, lässt sich mit Blick auf das Finanzwesen durchaus bestätigen. Denn dort hat sich eine politische Entscheidungsmacht konzentriert, die unter Umgehung demokratischer Prozeduren agiert und das Gemeinwohlinteresse missachtet. Es gilt daher, den Blick auf die Geldmacher und ihre damit verbundene Macht zu lenken. Einer der wichtigsten Geldmacher ist die Europäische Zentralbank (EZB), um deren Tätigkeit es in diesem Buch geht. Laut Steinhardt erweist sich die Politik der EZB zunehmend als Form einer Herrschaft, die man mit dem Begriff des autoritären Liberalismus kennzeichnen sollte. Diese These wird durch das Urteil des deutschen Bundesverfassungsgerichts im Jahr 2015 zu den Staatsanleihekaufprogrammen der EZB bestätigt. Die unkonventionelle Geldpolitik der EZB habe Verteilungswirkungen, die sich demokratisch nicht legitimieren lassen, lautete der Vorwurf. Ihre Beendigung im Zuge der Zinswende ist allerdings nicht als Fortschritt zu werten. Denn damit wird die Finanzstabilität gefährdet, wie der Zusammenbruch der Silicon Valley Bank belegte. Geldpolitik erweist sich bei genauerem Hinsehen als eine Form des Klassenkampfs, bei dem sich Zentralbanken eindeutig auf die Seite des Kapitals schlagen. Steinhardt plädiert deshalb für eine Reform des Geldsystems, die seiner Marktkonformität einen Riegel vorschiebt und die Geldmacher zwingt, sich stärker am Gemeinwohlinteresse zu orientieren.

The great strength of Italy lay in its constitution; its great weakness lay in certain legacies of the past. Organized crime—popularly but not exclusively associated with the mafia—is one example. A self-contained and well entrenched 'caste' of political and economic elites is another. These weaknesses became apparent in the breakdown of political order in the late 1980s and early 1990s. This ushered in a combination of populist political mobilization and experimentation with electoral systems design, and the result has been more evolutionary than transformative. Italian politics today is different from what it was during the immediate post-World War II period, but it still shows many of the influences of the past.

Economics and Diversity Carlo D'Ippoliti,2011-05-15 The bulk of contemporary economics assumes rather than explains differences between people or groups of people. Yet, many of these differences are produced by society or they imply differing opportunities and outcomes. This book argues that economists should concern themselves with the explanation of the social causes and effects of such differences. D'Ippoliti introduces the concept of diversity to summarise all differences that are of social origin and that a theory or model seeks to explain. This contrasts with the traditional concept of heterogeneity that instead refers to differences that are deemed to be exogenous of economic theory. In approaching this, the book ranges from the fields of methodology and history of economics to applied empirical work, as well as gender diversity which is considered in depth. The analysis of the thinking of two major economists of the past, John Stuart Mill and Gustav Schmoller, demonstrates how gender diversity exemplifies some of the fundamental issues in economics, such as the

division of labour, society's capacity to reproduce itself, and the role of social institutions and their impact on individual and collective behaviour. The book maintains that growth of GDP and of the services sector cannot be trusted to automatically bring about greater inclusion of women in the labour market. Active policy interventions are needed, spanning from the removal of discrimination to the provision of public services and the establishment of fair competition in the market, along with an improved division of social and political power between the sexes. This work will be of interest to researchers and students focusing on the history of economic thought, labour economics, social policy and gender studies.

A Compendium of Italian Economists at Oxbridge Mauro Baranzini, Amalia Mirante, 2016-09-21 This study examines five decades of Italian economists who studied or researched at the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge between the years 1950 and 2000.
