*Ein Land für Frauen* Marion Näser-Lather, 2019 Die gesellschaftliche Benachteiligung von Frauen und das sexistische Frauenbild in den Medien war 2011 in Italien Anlass zur Gründung der feministischen Bewegung *Se Non Ora Quando?* (wenn nicht jetzt, wann dann?). Diese Ethnographie untersucht Strukturbildungsprozesse, politische Visionen, Kommunikationsformen und Protestpraktiken der Bewegung. Die Autorin beleuchtet die Frage politischen Engagements auf der Basis der Kategorie Geschlecht und zeigt unter anderem am Beispiel des Umgangs mit digitalen Medien, dass die Möglichkeitsräume aktivistischen Denkens und Handelns in hohem Maße von Überzeugungen und Interaktionstraditionen beeinflusst werden können, die sich auch entgegen der Intentionen der Aktivistinnen in deren Diskurse und Praktiken einschreiben.
